

**Up to \$2,000 Reward Offered for Information
Leading to Arrest of Attempted Robbery Suspect**

Glendale, WI – February 23, 2010 – The Glendale Police Department and Northshore Crime Stoppers are offering a cash reward of up to \$2,000 for information leading to the arrest of the suspect(s) believed to be responsible for an attempted pharmacy robbery that occurred at MedPoint Pharmacy located at 2501 West Silver Spring Drive in Glendale.

Pharmaceutical company Purdue Pharma L.P. will match a \$1,000 reward previously offered by Northshore Crime Stoppers, raising the cash reward to up to \$2,000. Purdue Pharma operates RxPATROL[®], a collaborative effort between industry, pharmacists and law enforcement to collect, collate, analyze and disseminate information on pharmacy theft. “It’s important for people to know that all information that we get is kept completely confidential. Callers never have to give their names or appear in court. *Northshore Crime Stoppers* tip line does not use any tape recording or caller ID devices,” said *Crime Stoppers* coordinator Officer Joel Dhein.

Attempted Robbery Details for Public Announcement:

The Glendale Police Department is investigating an attempted pharmacy robbery that occurred at MedPoint Pharmacy, located at 2501 West Silver Spring Drive in Glendale. *Northshore Crime Stoppers* and law enforcement officials are asking for the public’s assistance by offering a reward. The amount has been increased from \$1,000 to up to \$2,000, with *Crime Stoppers* and Purdue Pharma, L.P. donating \$1,000 each.

- **Date/Time:** January 28, 2010, 1:22 PM
- **Location:** MedPoint Pharmacy, 2501 West Silver Spring Drive, Glendale, WI
- **Description of Events:** A suspect attempted to enter the pharmacy through a window while displaying a revolver. The suspect fled on foot after an employee pushed him back out of the window. A second suspect also fled on foot.
- **Suspect Description:** The first suspect is described as a black male in his late teens, approximately 5’9” tall, weighing 150-170 pounds. He wore a black knit hat and an orange and black jacket. The second suspect is described as a black male teen, approximately 5’8” tall weighing 180-200 pounds with dreadlocks and wore a black hooded jacket.
