

**Up to \$3,000 Reward Offered for Information
Leading to Arrest of Burglary Suspect**

Traverse, MI – May 7, 2010 – The Grand Traverse County Sheriff’s Department and Crime Stoppers are offering a cash reward of up to \$3,000 for information leading to the arrest of the suspect(s) believed to be responsible for a pharmacy burglary that occurred at Medicap Pharmacy located at 4025 Chums Village Drive in Traverse City.

The cash reward is donated by pharmaceutical company Purdue Pharma L.P., which operates RxPATROL[®], a collaborative effort between industry, pharmacists and law enforcement to collect, collate, analyze and disseminate information on pharmacy theft. Burglary Details for Public Announcement:

The Grand Traverse Sheriff’s Department is investigating a pharmacy burglary that occurred at the Medicap Pharmacy located at 4025 Chums Village Drive in Traverse City. The *Grand Traverse Area Silent Observer Program* and law enforcement officials are asking for the public’s assistance by offering a reward of up to \$3,000, donated by Purdue Pharma L.P., for any information that will help solve this crime.

- **Date/Time:** February 10, 2010, 1:57 AM
- **Location:** Medicap Pharmacy, 4025 Chums Village Drive Traverse City, MI
- **Description of Events:** The suspect entered the pharmacy through the front door, where glass had been broken and took an undetermined amount of prescription medicines. It is believed the same suspect may be responsible for several other burglaries in the area.
- **Suspect Description:** The suspect is described as a heavy set male, approximately 5’10”- 6’0” tall. He wore all dark clothing and was carrying a dark colored backpack. Attached are security photos of the suspect.
