

**Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered for Information
Leading to Arrest of Burglary Suspect**

Rittman, OH – June 4, 2010 – The Rittman Police and Crime Stoppers are offering a cash reward of up to \$1,000 for information leading to the arrest of the suspect(s) believed to be responsible for a pharmacy burglary that occurred at Ritzman Pharmacy located at 234 North Main Street in Rittman.

The cash reward is donated by pharmaceutical company Purdue Pharma L.P., which operates RxPATROL[®], a collaborative effort between industry, pharmacists and law enforcement to collect, collate, analyze and disseminate information on pharmacy theft. Burglary Details for Public Announcement:

The Rittman Police Department is investigating a pharmacy burglary that occurred at Ritzman Pharmacy located at 234 North Main Street in Rittman. *Crime Stoppers* and law enforcement officials are asking for the public’s assistance by offering a reward of up to \$1,000, donated by Purdue Pharma L.P., for any information that will help solve this crime.

- **Date/Time:** Tuesday, April 27, 2010 4:39AM
- **Location:** Ritzman Pharmacy, 234 North Main Street, Rittman, OH
- **Description of Events:** One suspect broke a window with a hammer and stood as a lookout while another suspect took an undetermined amount of prescription medicines. According to local authorities, it is believed that this same suspect burglarized this location in the past.
- **Suspect Description:** One suspect is described as a white male in his twenties. He wore a black stocking cap, black jacket and grey pants. The second suspect is described as a white male in his twenties wearing a purple knit hat and a black jacket.
