

**Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered for Information Leading to Arrest
Of Suspect(s) Involved in Pharmacy Burglary**

August 20, 2010, Eighty Four, PA - The North Strabane Police Department and Crime Stoppers are offering a cash reward of up to \$1,000 for information leading to the arrest of the suspect(s) believed to be responsible for a pharmacy burglary that occurred in the Eighty Four area.

The North Strabane Police Department is investigating a pharmacy burglary that occurred at the Prescription Center Plus Pharmacy located at 1045 Route 519 in Eighty Four, PA. Crime Stoppers and law enforcement officials are asking for the public's assistance by offering the reward for any information that will help solve this crime. The cash reward is donated by pharmaceutical company Purdue Pharma L.P., which operates RxPATROL[®], a collaborative effort between industry, pharmacists and law enforcement to collect, collate, analyze and disseminate information on pharmacy theft. Burglary Details for Public Announcement:

The North Strabane Police Department is investigating a pharmacy burglary that occurred at Prescription Center Plus Pharmacy, located at 1045 Route 519 in Eighty Four, PA. *Crime Stoppers* and law enforcement officials are asking for the public's assistance by offering the reward for any information that will help solve this crime.

- **Date/Time:** August 4, 2010, Approximately 3:12AM
- **Location:** Prescription Center Plus Pharmacy, 1045 Route 519, Eighty Four, PA 15330
- **Description of Events:** A suspect used a sledgehammer to smash the front door. Once inside, he took a large amount of controlled substances and fled out the front door. The suspect fled in what appears to be a red 2000 Pontiac Grand Prix with a rear spoiler and sun roof. The front passenger tire was an "after factory" chrome tire. The rear passenger tire was a "factory" tire. Security photos are attached.
- **Suspect Description:** The suspect is described as a white male, between 6' - 6'2" tall. He wore a charcoal gray hooded sweatshirt, blue colored latex gloves, light blue jeans with a black trash bag hanging from the right front pocket and white sneakers. The suspect wore a mask or bandana to cover his face.
